## **Dear Friends**

About two or three times a week I watch an aerobatic display that is fast, precise and incredible. I'm enthralled every time. It's performed by a group of pigeons that live under the Melling bridge. Their performance reminds me of the Red Arrows squad of the RAF in England. As I watch questions tumble in my mind. Which bird starts the flights? Who takes the lead in the maneuvers? How do they do it at such speed without crashing into each other? These and other questions arise when you see thousands of starlings wheeling and performing a great ballet in the sky. Then we may see a TV documentary that presents the same issues among fish, vast herds of wildebeest, or bison, and other species.

Now let's turn our attention to people. In the centuries before telephones and 'snail mail' people experienced situations where they received messages that gave them the clear and convincing sense that something was happening to someone they knew well—it was 'out of the blue'. Again and again it was verified as an event that was at the exact same time as they received or sensed the message. No instrument was involved like a telephone, let alone all our modern facilities like iphones, or Skyping, or TXTing. Of course there are always folk who dismiss such experiences as the result of vivid imaginations or wishful thinking. To escape ridicule people often keep quiet. However the number of such experiences reported is so vast that they cannot be rubbished. Even more so when we hear of twins who grow up apart and years later discover that their lives have been mirrored as if they shared one mind.

Perhaps you are wondering where all this is leading. My hope is to widen our view on the wonder and significance of the inner aspects of our being. This inner being we all have in common—gifts and abilities more powerful, positive and peace promoting than the forces that try to paralyse us with fear and terror. I'm not a scientist but there are discoveries that have been made which truly excite me. I understand that nothing can go faster than the speed of light—the sun's rays only take something like about 6-7 minutes to reach earth. Is that right?

Now we know there's something faster!

#### ENTANGLED BEINGS—ALL OF US!

In 1960 an Irish scientist named Bell, was able to show that sub-atomic particles— "once they have contact with other sub-atomic particles and then separated, then a change in one means a change in the other <u>instantly</u>, no matter how far apart." So here is something happening faster than the speed of light. Nick Herbert expresses it in this way:-

These connections and links take place without (a) having to travel through space, no instrument is needed, no signal is sent; (b) the strength of the connection does not fade or weaken no matter how distant; (c) these connections and changes are instantaneous.

This sort of happening is not confined to sub-atomic particles but also to the world of biology—of living creatures including ourselves. It has often been called entanglement. This is the point where we can begin to "see" some important and exciting implications.

- \* It seems to imply we can no longer believe that we are limited to what is within our skin. There is a sense in which we extend beyond the boundary of our bodies. We experience this when someone enters a room of people and the atmosphere or 'vibes' change—more aliveness or greater dullness. We pour out from our heart love to friend a 1000 miles away.
- \* Imagine a group of people (not necessarily together physically) who are on the same wavelength seeking peace, harmony and love in the world. Their prayers, hopes and love go out instantly to touch the lives of people near and far. Many sages and saints have said we seldom realise how often such outreach from our hearts and minds has actually prevented wars, conflicts and crime in the world. But this is not without discrimination. Other minds and attitudes don't dissolve into a bland sameness. For example a worried mother can connect with <a href="here">here</a> child not with all children.
- \* This may seem bread and butter stuff to most Christians. However we shouldn't make the mistake of imagining:
- (a) that we are the only ones who have discovered the power of this approach in a divided, battered and bruised world;
- (b) and we need to discover more widely that our thoughts and thinking patterns will never unite the world—and so far never looked likely to do it.
- (c) We can however look and note that every human being can and does say "I AM" on this we can all (and do) acknowledge our common individual ISness. This "isness" is the isness of God, the Absolute and IS an unchanging essence. At this point we are each one (one of the 7+ billion people) on common ground wrapped in a common undying love.

#### IT IS POSSIBLE— 'for this we have now'

Coleman Barks who translates much of Rumi's poetry says that a sense of Majesty is ... "felt as a presence, dawn, a company of friends, a splendour that is prior to and source of the universe.

Rumi says it is a state of awareness best spoken of in terms of what it is not."

This we have now is NOT imagination.
This is NOT grief or joy.
Not a judging state,
Not an elation
or sadness.
Those come and go.
This is the presence that
doesn't.

Love brings us back to that which we always are. The world famous palaeontologist and Christian saint and mystic says:-

"Being transformed by love is quite possible.

What paralyses life is failure to believe and failure to dare.
